

WEBSITE TERMS OF USE

Individuals and legal entities may use the Website and its Services only if they unconditionally accept these Website Terms of Use (the “Terms of Use”), the Public Offer Agreement available at <https://stattech.ru/docs/offer-en.pdf>, and the Privacy Policy available at <https://stattech.ru/docs/privacy-policy-en.pdf>. If you do not accept these Terms of Use in full, you may not use the Website or its Services.

1. Terms and Definitions

- 1.1. For the purposes of these Terms of Use, the following terms have the meanings set out below. Website means all pages within the stattech.ru domain. STATTECH Online Service means software provided by the Provider that enables the Customer to automate statistical data analysis using the service functionality made available under the Public Offer Agreement. Internet Resource means the collection of pages hosted on the Provider's server and forming the unified stattech.ru website. Content means dynamically updated graphic or text modules embedded in the code of an Internet Resource page and available for users to view or interact with. Public Offer Agreement means an agreement between the Provider and the Customer for the provision of services, concluded through acceptance of the Offer. User (Customer) means an individual or legal entity that has accepted the Public Offer Agreement in order to use the Internet Resource and its Services, thereby becoming a customer of the Provider and undertaking to comply with these Terms of Use. Provider means LLC "Stattech," which provides services to the Customer. Service means a technical solution made available by the Provider through the Internet Resource for the purpose of performing its obligations under the Agreement.

2. Provider's Rights

- 2.1. The Provider may restrict, suspend, or cancel the processing of a User's Application and may terminate performance of the Public Offer Agreement without compensation or payment if the Customer's actions or any information or materials supplied by the Customer violate the laws of the Russian Federation, the Public Offer Agreement, these Terms of Use, or the rights of third parties.
- 2.2. If the Provider identifies a violation of the lawful rights and interests of third parties, applicable laws of the Russian Federation, or these Terms of Use, the Provider may, at its discretion, delete Content or other information from the Internet Resource or its Services and/or block access to it.
- 2.3. Information about the status of the User's account and other information relevant to the use of the Internet Resource is recorded and stored by the Provider in the Internet Resource database.
- 2.4. The Provider may terminate or suspend the Services in the event of fraud or suspected fraud, a violation of any law or rule, or deliberate interference with the operation of the Internet Resource Services.
- 2.5. If the Provider suspects fraud, abusive conduct, or unlawful activity, it may report the matter to the relevant law enforcement and/or judicial authorities. This remedy is in addition to any other measures available to the Provider under the laws of the Russian Federation.
- 2.6. The Provider may change the design or content of the Internet Resource, the list of Services, any scripts, software, or other objects used or stored on the Internet Resource, and any server applications at any time, with or without prior notice.

2.7. The Provider does not pre-moderate or censor information or materials posted by Users. The Provider takes action to protect the rights and interests of persons and to ensure compliance with the laws of the Russian Federation only after receiving a properly submitted request from an interested person.

3. Restrictions on Use of the Internet Resource and its Services

3.1. When using the Internet Resource Services, the User must:

3.1.1. comply with the applicable laws of the Russian Federation, these Terms of Use, the Public Offer Agreement, and the Privacy Policy;

3.1.2. provide accurate, complete, and up-to-date information when registering on the Internet Resource or submitting an Application for services, and keep that information current. The User is responsible for the accuracy, currency, completeness, and legal compliance of all information and/or materials supplied to the Provider and for ensuring that they are free from third-party claims;

3.1.3. notify the Provider of any unauthorized access to and/or use of the User's password or login credentials;

3.1.4. refrain from posting through the Internet Resource Services any information or objects, including links, that may infringe the rights or interests of other persons;

3.1.5. assess the legality of posting any information or objects before posting them or supplying them to the Provider for the provision of services, including images of other persons, third-party texts, audio recordings, and video recordings.

3.2. If the User has any doubt as to whether an action is lawful, the Provider recommends refraining from that action.

3.3. When using the Internet Resource and its Services, the User is strictly prohibited from:

3.3.1. registering as a User or submitting an Application for services in the name of or instead of another person by creating a "fake account." Registration in the name and on behalf of another individual or legal entity is permitted only where the registering person has obtained the authority required by the laws of the Russian Federation in the prescribed form;

3.3.2. misleading the Provider as to the User's identity by using another registered User's login credentials and password;

3.3.3. posting or distributing through the Internet Resource Services, storing, supplying to the Provider for the provision of services, or otherwise using any information and/or materials that:

3.3.3.1. contain threats, discredit or insult another person, damage another person's honor, dignity, or business reputation, or violate the privacy of another User or third party;

- 3.3.3.2. infringe the rights of minors;
- 3.3.3.3. are vulgar or obscene, contain pornographic images or text, or depict sexual conduct involving minors;
- 3.3.3.4. depict cruelty to animals;
- 3.3.3.5. describe methods or means of suicide or encourage suicide;
- 3.3.3.6. promote or incite racial, religious, or ethnic hatred or hostility, fascism, or an ideology of racial supremacy;
- 3.3.3.7. contain extremist materials;
- 3.3.3.8. promote criminal activity or provide advice, instructions, or guidance on committing criminal acts;
- 3.3.3.9. contain restricted-access information, including state or trade secrets or information about the private lives of third parties;
- 3.3.3.10. advertise or present the use of narcotic substances as attractive, including so-called “digital drugs” consisting of audio files claimed to affect the brain through binaural rhythms; provide information about drug distribution, drug manufacturing instructions, or advice on drug use; or depict or describe smoking or the consumption of alcohol, narcotic substances, beer, or beer-based beverages;
- 3.3.3.11. are fraudulent;
- 3.3.3.12. otherwise infringe the rights or interests of individuals or legal entities or violate the laws of the Russian Federation.
- 3.3.4. unlawfully upload, store, publish, distribute, provide access to, or otherwise use intellectual property belonging to Users or third parties;
- 3.3.5. send bulk messages or spam without the required consent;
- 3.3.6. modify the software of the Internet Resource or any part of it, independently or through third parties, or use any automated means to access the Internet Resource;
- 3.3.7. copy, distribute, publish, decompile, disassemble, modify, transform, or otherwise reverse engineer the Internet Resource, or attempt to access source code for the purpose of creating derivative works based on the software source code or for any other purpose;
- 3.3.8. upload, store, publish, distribute, provide access to, or otherwise use viruses, Trojan horses, or other malicious software;
- 3.3.9. use automated scripts or programs to collect information from or interact with the Internet Resource or its Services without the Provider’s specific authorization;

- 3.3.10. unlawfully collect or process the personal data of other persons;
 - 3.3.11. access or attempt to access any service by means other than the interface provided by the Provider;
 - 3.3.12. post through the Internet Resource Services any other information or materials that, in the Provider's reasonable opinion, are undesirable, inconsistent with the purpose of the Internet Resource, detrimental to Users' interests, or otherwise unsuitable for publication on the Internet Resource.
- 3.4. The User is solely responsible for any information or materials that the User posts on the Internet Resource through its Services or communicates to other Users, and for any interaction with third parties undertaken at the User's own risk.

4. Intellectual Property

- 4.1. All intellectual property used or made available on the Internet Resource, including its design elements, branding, logos, texts, graphic images, illustrations, photographs, videos, software, music, and other objects, as well as the Internet Resource itself, belongs to its respective lawful rights holders and is protected by the laws of the Russian Federation. All rights to such objects are reserved (the "Intellectual Property").
- 4.2. Except as permitted by these Terms of Use or applicable laws of the Russian Federation, no Intellectual Property may be copied, reproduced, adapted, distributed, published, downloaded, transferred, sold, or otherwise used in whole or in part without the rights holder's prior permission, unless the rights holder has expressly authorized unrestricted use of the relevant Content.
- 4.3. Except for the User's own Content, the User may not post or otherwise make available through the Internet Resource Services any intellectual property taken from other websites, databases, or other sources without the rights holder's express consent.
- 4.4. Any use of the Internet Resource or Content other than as permitted by these Terms of Use or expressly authorized by the rights holder is strictly prohibited without the rights holder's prior written permission.

5. Liability

- 5.1. The Provider is not responsible for malfunctions, errors, or failures in software supporting the operation of the Internet Resource where they arise for reasons beyond the control of the Internet Resource, or for any resulting losses incurred by the User.
- 5.2. The Provider is not responsible for losses incurred by the User as a result of unlawful acts by third parties, including unauthorized access to the User's account.
- 5.3. The Provider is not responsible for any materials, information, messages, opinions, or services posted by the Customer on the Internet Resource or through its Services. The User acknowledges that the Provider does not control and is not responsible for the content of third-party Internet resources, the Customer's products or services,

or information and materials posted by the Customer through the Internet Resource and its Services or supplied to the Provider for the provision of services, including advertising offers and promotions.

- 5.4. The Provider does not represent or warrant that any information posted, uploaded, or distributed through the Internet Resource or its Services is accurate, current, or reliable.
- 5.5. The User is solely responsible for any information and/or materials uploaded or otherwise made publicly available through the Internet Resource or its Services. The User may not upload, transmit, or publish information on the Internet Resource or through its Services unless the User holds the rights required to do so under the laws of the Russian Federation. A violation of these Terms of Use or applicable laws of the Russian Federation may result in civil, administrative, or criminal liability.

6. Final Provisions

- 6.1. These Terms of Use constitute an agreement between the User (Customer) and the Provider governing the use of the Internet Resource and its Services.
- 6.2. By using the Internet Resource and its Services, the Customer unconditionally accepts these Terms of Use.
- 6.3. These Terms of Use form an integral part of the Public Offer Agreement.
